■ Individual Membership

Associate membership – Available to non-CSWE members who are not members of CSWE through a program's institutional membership.

- Eligibility - Ideal for those connected to social welfare agencies (national, state, local)
- Open to professional social work association members
- Field instructors with educational duties in social work programs
- Retired social work education professionals

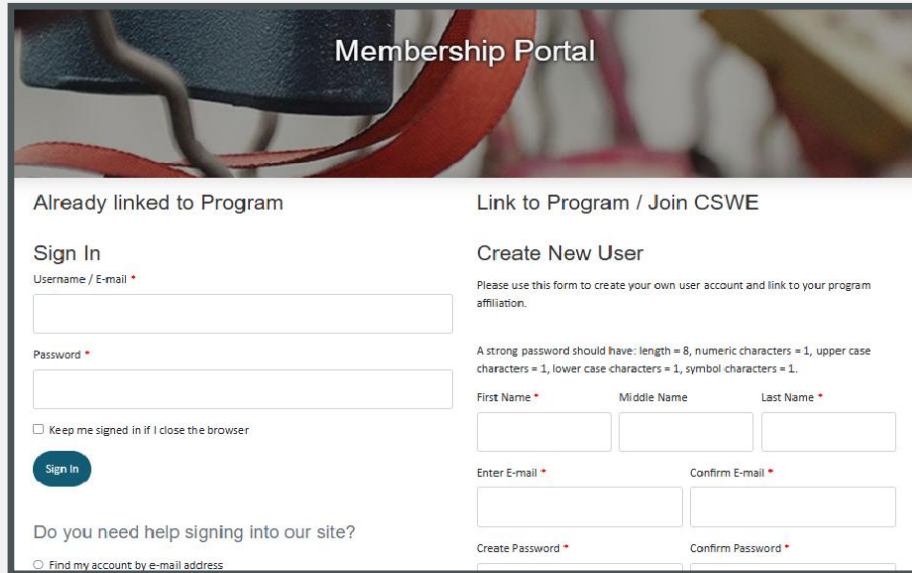

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OVERVIEW OF RESEARCH & STATISTICS AT CSWE

- Research & Statistics is a function of CSWE's Division of Education
 - *We are not apart of accreditation and do not manage accreditation surveys and data*
- Conducts the [Annual Survey of Social Work Programs](#)
- Works alongside [Commission on Research](#) to support CSWE member programs and develop research projects with guidance from CSWE Commissions and Councils
- Assist division of education programs with data & evaluation collection and reporting:
 - **Minority Fellowship Program (MFP)**
 - **Substance Use Disorders Education and Leadership Scholars Program (SUDEALs)**
 - **Doctoral Student Policy Fellowship (DSPF)**
 - **Grant applications**
 - **Policy briefs**
 - **Webinars**



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ANNUAL SURVEY OF SOCIAL WORK PROGRAMS

- Administered yearly to all accredited CSWE programs.
 - PhD programs are not accredited, but are still included in the survey distribution
 - This is not a function of accreditation, but CSWE uses graduate data to determine membership dues rate
- Survey opens in March of every year and closes in June of the same year (3-month survey project).
 - Completion is optional, but our data and ability to advocate is diminished in low-response years
- Annual Survey Report is available for free on CSWE's website, dating back to 2004-2005 Annual Survey.
- **Research & Statistics team is always happy to respond to data requests and provide additional data that is not included in the report. This is available upon request and the capacity of CSWE staff.**



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ANNUAL SURVEY CONTINUED

What is the Annual Survey?

- Annual Survey of Social Work Programs collects essential data on trends, challenges, and innovations in social work education across the United States.

What is measured in the Annual Survey?

- The Annual Survey collects data on enrollment, student and faculty demographics, curriculum changes, field placements, program structure, and more.

Who completes the Annual Survey?

- The Annual Survey is completed in collaboration with our member programs. The Annual Survey is distributed to accredited BSW, MSW, and DSW programs in addition to PhD programs.

What is the Annual Survey used for?

- A resource for faculty, program leaders, researchers, and policymakers seeking to understand and strengthen social work education.



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ANNUAL SURVEY CONTINUED

Changes to the Annual Survey (2025)

- Survey was broken down into individual sections by program level and program/faculty level surveys.
- Programs could only submit 1 response per survey project. If a program needed to make changes, they had to contact research@cswe.org to get a retake link
- Reworked survey questions:
 - Ensure accurate and clean data collection
 - Ensure that the definitions and language used are inline with CSWE accreditation and federal definitions (work in progress)
- Functional table of contents that includes progress tracker



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ANNUAL SURVEY CONTINUED

2023-2024 Annual Survey of Social Work Programs (**Publication:** Winter 2025)

- Low response year – only 689 responses (374 BSW, 255 MSW, 8 DSW, and 52 PhD)
 - 22-23 Annual survey had 859 responses (479 BSW, 303 MSW program responses, 14 DSW, and 63 PhD)
- Report will be more focused on presenting the data and less on analysis
- No longitudinal analysis due to low response count

2024-2025 Annual Survey of Social Work Programs (**Target Publication:** Late Spring/Early Summer 2026)

- Response count back inline with previous annual survey reports (preliminary)
- Re-introduction of thorough analysis
- Launching a new look and feel to the Annual Survey report



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ANNUAL SURVEY CONTINUED

2025-2026 Annual Survey of Social Work Programs (**Survey Opens:** March 2026)

- Distributed to all accredited CSWE programs (BSW, MSW, and DSW) and PhD programs
- Survey will run from March to June 2026
- Structure of survey will be like 24-25 survey deployment
- Survey will be distributed to the program's primary contact. **Please make sure that your program information is up-to-date with your accreditation specialist.**



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FUTURE OF RESEARCH & STATISTICS AT CSWE

- Increase the accessibility of our data
- Increase reporting
 - Graduating student exit survey
 - Ad-hoc
 - Dynamic reporting
- Data dashboards
- Providing guidance on disruptive technologies
- Continued stewardship of data

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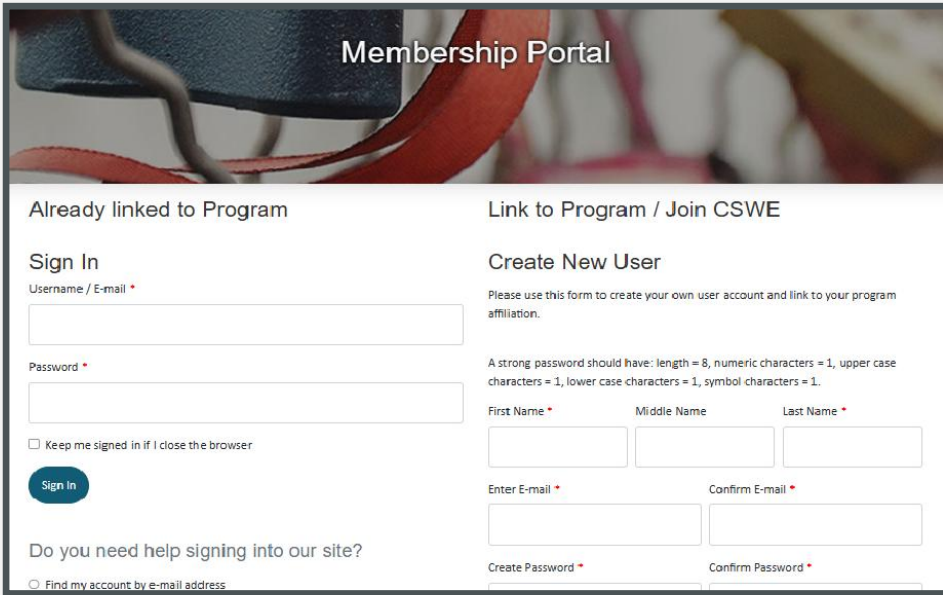

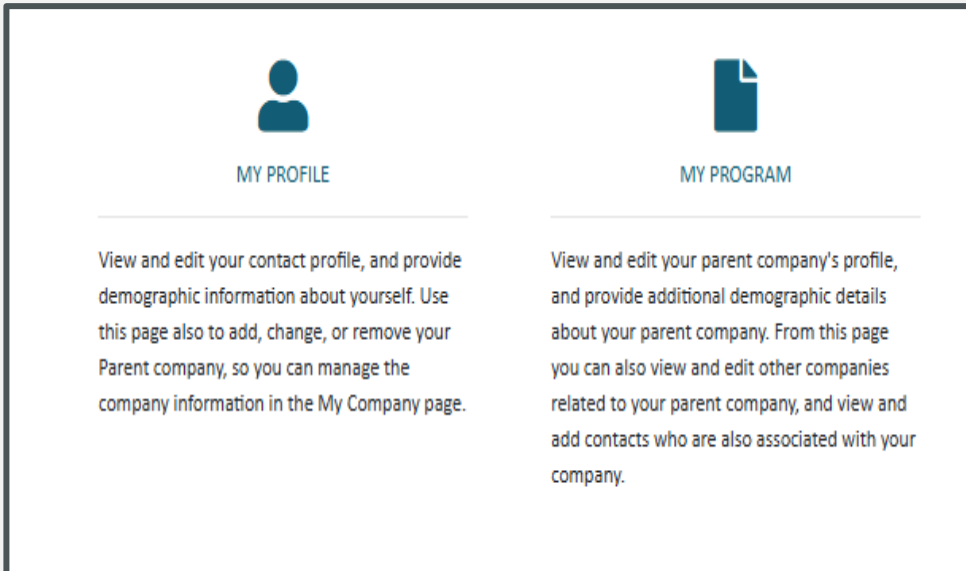

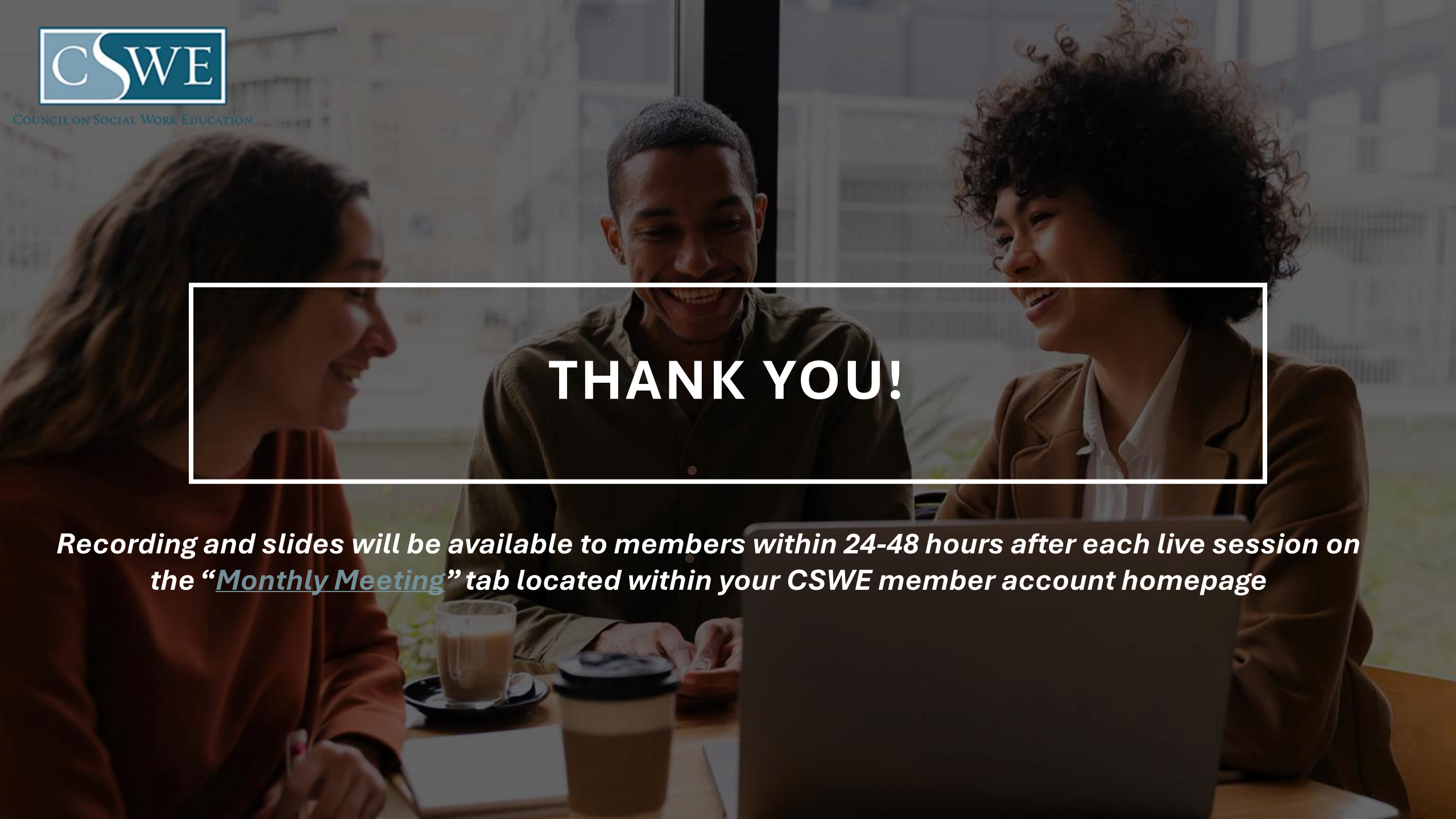
